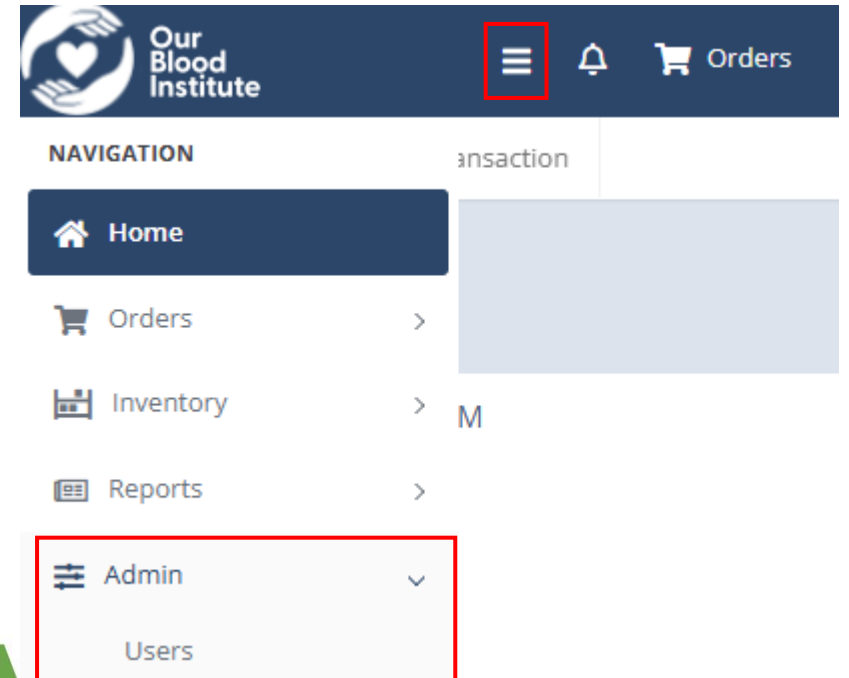

## How do I create a new user in BloodHub?

- New users must be created by a user with “Hospital Admin” access
- After you login to BloodHub, select the  icon
- Select Admin & a drop down menu will appear
- Select Users
  - This screen will show you all current users
- Click the  button

# Education – What really is the meaning of Rh negative & Rh positive?

- The Rh System
  - Second most important blood group after ABO
    - 56 different Rh antigens
    - Main antigens of interest: D, C, c, E, e
  - Rh status refers to the presence (Rh positive) or absence (Rh negative) of the D antigen
    - Approximately 85% of donors are Rh positive
- Anti-D antibody
  - IgG class → clinically significant
    - Extravascular hemolysis
    - Severe hemolytic disease of the fetus and newborn (HDFN)
- Providing Rh negative blood products should be prioritized for Rh negative women of childbearing potential
